

NorthWest Ohio Consortium of Coordinators For Gifted 2015 Scholarship Application

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Approximately five monetary awards of up to \$100.00 may be presented to students who demonstrate a strong passion (interest) in a specific area and can demonstrate how this award will support their passion.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. This award is open to all students identified as gifted and talented in grades K-12.
2. Applicants must be from school districts with representation in the NorthWest Ohio Consortium of Coordinators for Gifted.
3. All applications must be postmarked by February 20, 2015.
4. Recipients of this award should be able to present their passion and demonstrate how the award supported their passion at a future NWOCCG meeting. Presentations may be given personally or through any form of visual display such as video, poster, artwork, etc.

APPLICATION PROCESS

To apply for the NWOCCG scholarship, please return the following:

1. The application cover page
2. Two completed recommendation forms
3. An essay of *up to 500 words* about: (1) your passion (area of interest) and (2) how receiving the award will help in supporting or enhancing this passion. In the essay, (3) please be specific as to how the monetary award will be spent. Your essay will be evaluated on the inclusion of each of these aspects. Please type or print this essay and attach it to the application.

Examples of what you may spend your award on include, but are not limited to:

- Supplies/materials/instruments for art, music, theatre, etc.
- Reading materials pertaining to your passion
- How-to books
- Tools for building, creating, cooking, sewing, etc.
- Defraying the cost of a workshop, tuition for a class, conference, camp, etc.
- Hobbies

Note: This list is not considered exhaustive. It is merely intended as a general guide.
