Stephanie Tolan is a Newbery Honor-winning author of more than two dozen novels for children and young adults, Stephanie S. Tolan is also co-author of *Guiding the Gifted Child* and author of "Is It a Cheetah?" a metaphorical essay on gifted children that has been translated into more than 40 languages. A Senior Fellow at the Institute for Educational Advancement, she has written and spoken about the social, emotional and spiritual needs of gifted individuals for 30 years and helped design Yunasa, a summer camp for highly gifted kids that focuses on helping them bring balance to their lives.
