ELA – Third and Fourth grade pacing charts updated to include morphology training from summer and retrained yesterday. Spelling tests are NO MORE! 7-12 textbooks are in place. HS working on rewriting pacing guides. Collections has six themes so buildings need to decide on what four themes to complete at their grade levels. **Textbook replacements are a building responsibility.** Only if enrollment exceeds book order will district provide more textbooks.

Social Studies – assessment portal has released questions from last year to be included in S.L.O test bank. Harmony to be on state American Government committee
