Report from Curriculum Guide Committee:

CTL's travelled to Cincinnati Public Schools to meet with their curriculum department to get information about Curriculum guides.

Just got science access today to CPS guide. Used large teams of teacher volunteers over 5 months to get the work done (50-90 teachers). Everything was housed in a Google Drive. No hard copies were printed or distributed to force teachers to keep up to date with the digital content. Used links to ODE model curriculum and their content text-based resources.

Technology embedded in each curriculum. Capstone Projects by grade level across the district. Pacing guides DO look similar to each other across subjects.

ELA – Third quarter walkthrough for READ 180/System 44 program implementation is on the schedule. Waiting for Benchmarking to finish to export data. Third quarter TBT assessments have been sent out.

Science – Tbt third quarter assessments were completed. Walkthrough document for evaluating new programs are ready. Lab-Aids PD scheduled for grades 6-8 today and tomorrow.

Arts – All new arts standards are out and teachers are being trained at February In-Service. Revision of Dance standards being done state wide and Liberty teachers are on the state committee. PE teachers piloting program for state this year that whole state will be using next year.
