NORTH MIDDLE SCHOOL PROPOSAL FOR CURRICULUM COUNCIL

- Career Choices curriculum would supplement what is available in the Ohio Means Jobs Backpack for students.
- The curriculum will allow us to complete student success plans required for all at-risk 6th grade students in our building.
- Career Choices will specifically help with the requirement for students to begin their Career Pathway Goals – considering how their interests may influence their long-term goals.
- The Ohio Means Jobs Backpack is just one tool, and with Career Choices, students can explore career and lifestyle goals with greater depth and meaning.
- We would propose to use this with all of our 6th grade students during our classroom meeting time once a week.
- By the end of the course, all of our students would then have a Student Success plan and not just those that required one.
- The curriculum was written at a 6th grade level and creative lessons designed to engage students in career exploration and thinking towards their future.
- We would like to purchase 30 student textbooks, 30 workbooks, access to the online teacher materials and the My10yearplan.com account.
- The proposed cost is quoted on page 3.
