### Committee Updates

#### Arts –

#### Career Tech –

We are taking applications for the 2020-2021 school year. Most program numbers look average or above. We still have about 1/3 of the sophomores who have not turned in applications yet.

Our new agriculture teacher started Monday, November 11. He has been involved in helping write a grant, meetings with businesses, choosing curriculum and textbooks so far.

#### ELA –

The high school ELA teachers received Edgenuity follow up training this month. We learned that we are able to customize the ELA End of Course prep course to align it to our pacing guide. The ELA 9/10 teachers are working on creating that customization to use after break.

The elementary coaches are partners and completing OG/Morphology walkthroughs in ALL reading classrooms and were given a deadline of Jan. 10 to be completed. They are all using Google Form Publisher for this so the results are automatically tallied and a pdf generated for the teacher.

The ELA Implementation Team will be meeting in early December to begin the textbook adoption process for K-6.

EOC retakes will begin Dec. 2 and will be completed before Christmas break.

**Math –**

Meeting with Freedom's grade 3 teachers. The implementation of number talks, mathematical tasks, purposeful planning are a few of the topics we have been discussing.

Met with West's grades 7 and 8 math teachers. I was given a day to work with both groups (half day for each math team). During that time, we were able to unwrap a unit's standards, determine prerequisite skills needed for the unit and the learning progress for the standards in that unit. Next, we used that information to create the pretest and the criteria for success that was aligned to the priority standard for that unit. Finally, we were able to begin the discussion of their TBT strategy and all the components of this strategy that's needed for effective implementation.

Will be meeting with Algebra 1 and Geometry teachers in December to continue our learning sessions.

Textbook committee is beginning to review material using our agreed upon rubric. However, we will not be adopting math textbooks during this year.

**Science – Nothing to report****Social Studies –**

Middle schools are working on welcoming Huntington Bank to do a simulation for students hosted @ West which will cover the financial education standards in their grades. This is tentatively scheduled between Thanksgiving and New Year's.

**Special Ed. –**

The special education administrators are currently attending the OCALI (Ohio Coalition for Autism and Low Incidence) Conference in Columbus this week. The conference is offering sessions/support with such topics as: Co-Planning/Serve; Curriculum; Internal Monitoring; Disproportionality; Behavior Management; Assistive Technology, and Data Collection. The conference provides access to current information, ODE updates, and the opportunity to network with individuals who are also serving students with disabilities.
